ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA:

- MUST RENT YOUR HOME
- HOUSEHOLD IS LOW-INCOME
- EXPERIENCED FINANCIAL HARDSHIP DUE TO COVID-19 INCLUDING:
 - REDUCED INCOME
 - JOB LOSS (UNEMPLOYMENT)
 - UNABLE TO WORK DUE TO NO CHILDCARE/SCHOOL
 - *OTHER FINANCIAL HARDSHIP*
- RESIDE IN THE **CIHA SERVICE AREA:**
 - **COLVILLE INDIAN RESERVATION & TRIBAL TRUST LAND**
 - **CHELAN, DOUGLAS, FERRY, OKANOGAN, & STEVENS COUNTIES**
