NOTICE: TREE TRIMMING 2021

The PUD will continue tree trimming and pruning trees within the right-of-way. This includes trees/shrubs that are interfering with overhead conductors (power lines) and/or pad mounted transformers that are a hazard to PUD infrastructure. The PUD will be trimming trees in the following areas in 2021 (not necessarily in this order):

- Aeneas Valley/Chewiliken/20E/Lyman Lake
- Oroville
- Twisp/Carlton/Twisp River
- *Hwy 153/Methow*
- Malott
- Old 97
- Okanogan/Elmway
- North Pine Creek
- Hazard Trees as necessary
- IF you have trees on your property that are interfering with PUD overhead high voltage conductors, or do not meet minimum clearance standards, they are scheduled to be trimmed on this cycle.
- Secondary or service lines (those that deliver power to your residence, specifically from the transformer to the home, shop, pump) are not included in this maintenance.
- The PUD is also seeking removal of danger trees, fast growing trees, trees that require extensive trimming and trees that interfere with lines and PUD equipment. These removals will qualify for the PUD Tree Replacement Program. Generally, no tree will be removed without your permission.
- IF YOU DO NOT HAVE TREES INTERFERING WITH PUD POWER LINES, OR THEY HAVE BEEN RECENTLY TRIMMED AND HAVE REQUIRED CLEARANCE, OR YOUR AREA IS NOT INCLUDED IN THIS NOTICE, PLEASE DISREGARD THIS NOTICE.
