**A Resolution Establishing DS-1 (T1) Rates  
on the District's Telecommunication System**

**WHEREAS**, the District has installed a fiber-optic telecommunications system to provide wholesale telecommunications services to retail providers; and


**WHEREAS**, the District has established rates for wholesale services charged to retail providers; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary to periodically review the rates to verify the services offered and charges for such services are fair and reasonable; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined it needs to offer rates for various configurations of DS1 service.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County adopt DS1 (T1) Rate Schedule attached hereto, to be effective March 1, 2008.


