RESOLUTION NO. 1481

A Resolution of the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County Establishing New Internet Rates on the District's Telecommunication System

WHEREAS, the District has installed a fiber-optic telecommunications system to provide wholesale telecommunications services to retail providers; and

WHEREAS, the District has established rates for wholesale services charged to retail providers; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to periodically review the rates to verify the services offered and charges for such services are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined it needs to offer smaller fixed bandwidth levels for small Internet service and establish new rates for large demand Internet customers; and

WHEREAS, this Resolution rescinds and replaces Resolution No. 1329 without affecting the terms of existing written contracts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County rescinds the existing Wholesale Internet rate established by Resolution No. 1329 and adopts the Wholesale Internet Rate Schedule attached hereto to be effective April 1, 2009, without affecting the terms of existing written contracts.

Okanogan PUD Wholesale Internet Rate Schedule

Any Authorized Retail Service Provider is eligible to purchased dedicated Internet bandwidth from the Okanogan County Public Utility District on a wholesale basis. Internet bandwidth is a burstable product and is billed at 95th percentile usage for the previous calendar month, rounded up to the next Mbps. The rate structure for said services is as follows:

Dedicated Internet Access (12 Month Term Contract)	
Cost per Meg per month for a 1 meg minimum commitment	\$155.00
Cost per Meg per month for a 10 Meg minimum commitment	\$145.00
Cost per Meg per month for a 20 Meg minimum commitment	\$135.00
Cost per Meg per month for a 40 Meg minimum commitment	\$125.00

Wholesale Internet point of demarcation is the Roger Mills Building, 18 W. 1st Ave., Omak, WA.
