

RESOLUTION NO. 1484

**A Resolution of the Commissioners
of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County
Establishing Wholesale Wireless Rates on the District's Telecommunication System**

WHEREAS, the District has installed a fiber-optic telecommunications system to provide wholesale telecommunications services to retail providers; and

WHEREAS, the District has established rates for wholesale services charged to retail providers; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to periodically review the rates to verify the services offered and charges for such services are fair and reasonable; and

WHEREAS, the District has determined it needs to offer rates for various configurations of SONET service.

WHEREAS, this Resolution amends and supplements Resolution No. 1459 without affecting the terms of existing written contracts.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County amends and supplements rates established by Resolution No. 1459 and adopts the Wireless Rate Schedule attached hereto, to be effective July 1, 2009, without affecting the terms of existing written contracts.

Okanogan PUD Wireless Rate Schedule

Ethernet & Wireless - Monthly and Non-Recurring Charges: Bundled Rate.

Bundled Rate definition: An Internet Service Provider (ISP) who purchases wholesale internet bandwidth from Okanogan County PUD at a minimum commit rate of 1.75% times its total bandwidth capacity rounded up to nearest whole number.

Total Bandwidth Capacity is calculated as follows:

Number of 512K Kits times .5 Plus
 Number of 1024K Kits times 1 Plus
 Number of 2048K Kits times 2 Plus
 All Basic Fiber Ports times 10
 Equals Total Bandwidth Capacity
