

**RESOLUTION NO. 1532**

**A Resolution of the Commissioners  
of Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County  
Establishing Wholesale WiFi Rates on the District's Telecommunication System**

**WHEREAS**, the District has installed a fiber-optic telecommunications system to provide wholesale telecommunications services to retail providers; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has established a WiFi system for wholesale services charged to retail providers; and

**WHEREAS**, the District has determined it needs to offer rates for various configurations of WiFi service; and


**WHEREAS**, attached to this Resolution as Exhibit A is a schedule of rates for WiFi services;



# Okanogan PUD WiFi Wireless Rate Schedule

**Monthly and Non-Recurring Charges: Bundled Rate.**

**Bundled Rate definition:** An Internet Service Provider (ISP) who purchases all their wholesale internet bandwidth from Okanogan County PUD or at a minimum commit rate of 10% times its total bandwidth capacity rounded up to nearest whole number.

**Total Bandwidth Capacity is calculated as follows:**

Number of Tier 1 services times 1 Plus  
 Number of Tier 2 services times 2 Plus  
 Number of Tier 3 services times 3 Plus  
 Number of Tier 4 services times 5 Plus  
 Number of Tier 5 services times 7 Plus  
 All Basic Fiber Ports times 10  
 Equals Total Bandwidth Capacity
