## **RESOLUTION NO. 1703**

## A Resolution to Establish a Renewable Energy Credit for Community Solar Projects

WHEREAS, the Public Utility District No. 1 of Okanogan County ("District") supports renewable energy development; and

WHEREAS, the "District" applied for and has been pre-certified by Washington State University as a Utility Administered Community Solar Project ("Project") in the State of Washington and qualifies for state funded incentives as allowed by RCW 82.16; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to establish the value of each kilowatt of energy generated by the "Project" and subsequently credited back to participants' electric accounts;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of Commissioners authorize that energy generated by the "Project" shall be valued at 5 cents per kilowatt hour.
